

Rounding Decimals



Objective

Rounding decimals to the nearest whole number and 1 decimal place



Equipment

- Enrich Education Control Markers
- Enrich School Orienteering Map
- Worksheet
- Clipboard (suggested)



Preparation

- Select and print Activity Sheets.



Instructions

- Teacher to assign groups of 2 or 3 to their starting points.
- Pupils use the Enrich school orienteering map to locate their starting point and each of the control points indicated on the Activity Sheets.
- At each control point, pupils fill in the four numbers from the control marker. The Activity Sheets include a decimal point between the 1st/2nd and 3rd/4th numbers, so that pupils create a number with two decimal places.
- Using the numbers that they create; pupils then must round up/down to the nearest whole number or to the nearest 1 decimal place (as instructed on their Activity Sheet).



Other information

- Remind pupils of the teacher's location for the task.
- Pupils to complete their first 5 questions and report back to the teacher.
- After a quick check the pupils can carry on with the activity.
