Add the Apostrophe

Objective

Using apostrophes for contracted forms



Equipment

- Enrich School Orienteering Map
- Orienteering Control Markers
- Activity Sheets (1,2,3)



- Children could do this activity in pairs or small groups.
- The activity involves children inserting an apostrophe into sentences which are based on the pictures of animals on the control markers.
- There are three different Activity Sheets that teachers can select from.
- Provide children with a copy of the school's orienteering map and one of the Activity Sheets.
- Explain to children how to complete the activity.

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Instructions

- Children use their Orienteering map to locate the control points that are numbered next to each sentence on their Activity Sheets.
- They look at the picture of the animal on the control marker and fill in the name of the animal to complete the sentence on their Activity Sheet.
- They then insert the missing apostrophes into any contracted words in the sentence.
- They then use their map to locate the control point for the next sentence and continue with the activity.

(Control Points can be visited in any order).



Activity Sheets can be laminated so that they can be used on several occasions.
