Adjectives Missing Letters



Objective

Building a rich vocabulary – extending the range of familiar adjectives.



Equipment

- Activity Sheets
- Enrich School Orienteering Map
- Orienteering Control Markers



Preparation

- This activity involves children using the letters on specific control markers to fill in the missing letters in adjectives. The adjectives included in this activity are all 'positive' adjectives.
- The Activity Sheet contains 5 separate sheets.
 Teachers can select different sheets to give to
 different pairs/groups of children. They can also
 select and print off individual sheets from within
 the document.
- Teachers can add in some of the missing letters for individual words to reduce the challenge.
- Children could do this activity in pairs or small groups.
- Provide each pair/group with a copy of the school's orienteering map and an Activity Sheet,
- Explain to the children how to carry out the activity.



Instructions

- Children use their Enrich school orienteering map to locate each control point specified on their Activity Sheet.
- When they locate a control point, they must select from the letters on the marker to complete the missing letters from the adjective on their Activity Sheet.
 - NB They will not need to use all the four letters from the marker and letters can be used more than once.
- There is also a clue, based on meaning/synonyms to help children complete the word.

The adjectives used in this activity are as follows:

- · Control 15 memorable
- · Control 6 tremendous
- Control 3 beautiful
- Control 4 phenomenal
- Control 11 immaculate
- $\bullet \ \mathsf{Control} \, \mathsf{7} \mathsf{incomparable}$
- Control 5 elegant
- Control 8 optimistic
- Control 13 fascinating
- Control 10 unmistakeable
- Control 1 captivating
- Control 12 precious
- Control 9 encouraging
- Control 14 triumphant
- Control 2 delightful



Other information

- As a follow up activity, children could select two or three of the adjectives that they collected and compose a sentence for each one.
- Teachers could use all the adjectives to create a class collection. This could be used to explore meanings, spelling patterns etc.
- Children could also explore linked words e.g. capture/captivate, phenomenon/phenomenal, incomparable/compare etc.
- Adjectives collected could be displayed in a class poster.
