

Alphabet Order



Objective

Put words into alphabetical order based on first two, three or four letters.



Equipment

- Activity Sheets
- Enrich School Orienteering Map
- Orienteering Control Markers



Preparation

- Teachers can use the prepared Activity Sheets. There are four alternative Activity Sheets for this activity (to 2nd letter x 2, to 3rd letter, to 3rd and 4th letters)
- Alternatively, teachers can select a specific set of control points for this activity and insert the numbers for these control points into the editable Activity Sheets. They can also specify which letter (either 1st/2nd/3rd/4th) from the control markers that children need to write into their Activity Sheet to show that they have visited each control point.



Instructions

- Children could do this activity in pairs.
- Children locate each specified control point indicated on their Activity Sheet, using their Enrich school orienteering map.
- At each control point they write in the specified letter (1st/2nd/3rd/4th) to collect the word.
- When they have collected all the words on their Activity Sheet, they must then write them in alphabetical order on their Activity Sheet.



Other information

- As a follow-up vocabulary activity, children could select two or three of the words that they collected, check their meaning in their dictionary and write a sentence for each of them.
- (The words are in sets that are synonyms/have linked meanings)
