Alphabet Order to 2nd Letter



Objective

Put words into alphabetical order based on first two <u>letters</u>.



Equipment

- Enrich School Orienteering Map
- Orienteering Control Markers
- Activity Sheets



Preparation

- Children could do this activity in pairs or small groups.
- The activity involves children using the letters from specified control markers to complete words in a set, and then putting the set of words into alphabetical order.
- There are two different Activity Sheets that teachers can select from: adjectives meaning fantastic/wonderful; verbs about looking.
- Provide children with a copy of the school's orienteering map and one of the Activity Sheets.
- Explain to children how to complete the activity.



Instructions

- Children use their Orienteering map to locate the control points that are numbered next to each word on their Activity Sheets.
- They use the letters from the control marker to complete the word.
- When they have completed the six words in the set, they then write them into alphabetical order using the 1st and, where necessary, 2nd letters. (Control Points can be visited in any order).



Other information

Activity Sheets can be laminated so that they can be used on several occasions.

As a follow-up activity, children could select some of the words that they completed and put each one into a sentence.
