Britain Geography Quiz 1



Objective

Name and locate key topographical features of the United Kingdom.



Equipment

- Activity Sheets
- Enrich School Orienteering Maps.
- Orienteering Control Markers



Preparation

- Children could complete this activity in pairs or small groups.
- Provide each pair/group with an Enrich Orienteering Map and an Activity Sheet.
- Explain to the children how to do the activity.
- There are two different Activity Sheets for this activity.



Instructions

- Children use their Enrich School Orienteering Map to locate the control points identified on their Activity Sheet.
- At each control point, they must read the clue and then fill in the missing letters to complete the answer, using the letters from the control marker to help them.
- They will not need to use all the letters from the marker and letters can be used more than once.
- All the 6 clues on each Activity Sheet are about different UK topographical /physical features.



Other information

- Children could take a UK atlas with them to help them complete this activity.
- Activity Sheets can be laminated, and children use whiteboard pens so that the sheets can be used on multiple occasions.
