

Change the Tense (Past -Present)



Objective

Use present and past tenses correctly and consistently



Equipment

- Enrich School Orienteering Map
- Orienteering Control Markers
- Activity Sheets



Preparation

- Children could do this activity in pairs or small groups.
- The activity involves children changing the verb/s in sentences to change them from past to present tense.
- There are three different Activity Sheets.
- Provide children with a copy of the school's orienteering map and one of the Activity Sheets.
- Explain to children how to complete the activity.



Instructions

- Children use their Orienteering map to locate the control points that are numbered next to each pair of sentences on their Activity Sheets.
- They look at the picture of the animal on the control marker and insert the name of the animal in the pair of sentences on their Activity Sheet.
- They then insert the appropriate verb/s in the second sentence to change the sentence from past to present tense.
- They then use their map to locate the control point for the next pair of sentences and continue with the activity.
(Control Points can be visited in any order).



Other information

Activity Sheets can be laminated so that they can be used on several occasions.
