## Cone Match

## Objective

A cooperative problem-solving physical activity.

## Equipment

- Cones


## Preparation

- Split the children equally into appropriate groups, taking into consideration ability and space available.
- Ask children to close their eyes and give each child a cone to hold on their head.
- Ensure there are a mixed number of coloured cones.
- Children can then open their eyes.


## (1) Other information

- Perform the activity where children need to group up with one of every colour cone to allow for a more challenging activity.


## $\equiv$ Instructions

- Children must find the most effective/efficient way to find everyone with the same colour cone on their head as them.
- In the first-round children can speak to each other so the game will go quickly.
- In the second-round children will play in silence so their tactics of communication will need to change.
- Provide the children with the rules:
- The cone must stay on their head until the end of the game.
- They should not peek at their cone colour.
- They should not tell anyone their cone colour or ask someone for their own.
