

Number Hunt



Objective

A competitive and cooperative physical activity involving number ordering.



Equipment

- Cones
- Number Cards



Preparation

- Split the children equally into appropriate groups, taking into consideration ability and space available.
- Place a coloured cone in front of each team.
- Place the remaining coloured cones for each team, (5), spread out at the other end approximately 20m in front of them.
- Take your number cards and place them under the cones for each team.



Instructions

- One person at a time from the teams should run and peek under one cone to find out the numbers under the cones.
- They will then work as a team to order the numbers and then run to reveal them in order.
- Children will therefore play the game in two stages. Their first run will identify which number is under which cone and their second run will be to collect the correct number in their team's sequence.
- Each team must work cooperatively to find where all their numbers are and reveal them in order.
- Provide the children with the rules: only one player from each team can run at a time, the numbers under each cone must be revealed in order, children can only look under one cone on their turn.



Other information

- Edit the numbers to allow for differentiation and Maths Curriculum links.
