

Route Recital



Objective

A cooperative physical activity which requires children to use their memory.



Equipment

- Enrich Blank Control Markers
- Enrich Interactive Map



Preparation

- Prior to the activity prepare your customisable map by adding 10 blank marker numbers onto it.
- Prior to the activity, place the blank markers around the school site referring to the map.
- Add unique information onto the markers which teams will need to remember (this can be something related to Outdoor Learning such as a tree) and keep an answer sheet handy.
- Split the children into pairs.
- Provide teams with a starting point in the centre of the area.
- Provide teams with an Enrich Interactive Map.



Instructions

- On go, the pairs must move around the school site locating the blank markers.
- They must try to remember all 10 items on the markers like the shopping list game e.g., I went to the markers, and I saw a tree.
- Once the pairs think they have finished, they must repeat the list back to a teacher.
- The game ends when a pair can recite all 10 items.



Other information

- Use fewer markers or create bigger teams to support differentiation.
