

Spiderweb



Objective

A competitive and cooperative physical activity which requires children to use their problem-solving skills in a team.



Equipment

- String
- Trees



Preparation

- Split the children into teams of 10, considering ability and cooperation.
- Prior to the lesson take 3 long pieces of rope/string and tie each of them around two adjacent trees to create a spider web effect.
- Try to make hole sizes different.



Instructions

- Explain to the children that they must pass through the web without anyone touching it.
- If a person touches the web, they must restart that player.
- At least 5 of the holes must be used.
- Children cannot use more than one hole consecutively.
- Each team must work cooperatively and communicate effectively to get through the spider's web the quickest.



Other information

- Allow teams 3 chances to touch the web to decrease difficulty levels.
