

Water Potato



Objective

A fun and exciting take on pass the parcel using water balloons.



Equipment

- Water balloons
- Music/Speaker



Preparation

- Fill water balloons and have everyone sit in a circle on the field.
- Give one person in the circle a water balloon.
- Set up a music speaker and begin playing music.



Instructions

- Players must pass the water balloon around the circle whilst music plays.
- The teacher must stop the music randomly (without looking at the circle so you don't know who has it) and whoever has the balloon when the music stops must pop the balloon above their head and is out of the game.
- If there's confusion about who has the water balloon when the music stops (e.g., two people are holding it or someone threw it after the music stopped), play rock paper scissors to decide.
- Play again and again until only one person remains.
- The aim of the game is for players to pass the balloon quickly around the circle to stay in the game.
- If a balloon is popped during play that player will be out of the game.
- This is to reduce the chance of children throwing the balloons to avoid being out.



Other information

- Give children one chance if the balloon pops during play.
