Let's get our heart rate up and get active!!

Use your maths skills to work out an area 4 meters long or longer if you have the space. Mark each end with an object from your house that is easy to see.

You will need to get creative and design your own tail. Use our template or have a go at making your own.

The two participants will stand back to back, facing their object with their designs tucked into their waist like a tail.

One participant will be a cat and one will be a dog, have an adult call out one of the animal's names. If there is no one to call out either cat or dog use a dice, the

That participant must run to their object without having their tail pulled out. If you haven't got the space you could crawl or shuffle instead of running.

Points are given for reaching the object or getting the oppositions tail. First to 5 or ten wins.

Two objects as markers

Tail design
