

Maths That Makes Me

What Maths make up you?

This activity gets you to look at the maths that surrounds you everyday but you just don't notice them! Things like the date of your birthday, height, shoe size, arm length and using these to create a work sheet or poster all about you!

It's your task to do a bit of inspection work about yourself and work out different equations. Firstly think of some numbers that are associated with you, like your shoe size in cm, mm or inches, Your age and your birthday date by day/month/ year. Once you have 5—10 of these you will need to turn these numbers in to an equation i.e. if you are aged 10 an equation of this might be $100/10$ or $1000/100$, if your house number is 104 an equation might be $(20 \times 3 + 50 - 6)$.

You can use the 'Maths That Makes Me' work sheet or you can create your own, illustrate each section / equation
