Explore Ancient Egyptian Ruins

The Egyptians are an ancient civilisation dating back to 3100 BC. The Egyptian empire was a one of the greatest and most powerful in history. The civilisation was located along the river Nile in North East Africa. They are famous for building pyramids, these pyramids and tombs were used to bury pharaohs. Their alphabet was formed by using **hieroglyphs**, with over 700 different symbols and shapes.

One of the pharaohs was Ramesses VI, he was the fifth ruler of the Twentieth Dynasty of Egypt. He reigned in the mid-to-late 12th century BC for around 8 years.

Your activity is to virtually explore Ramesses VI tomb, walk through the different halls and chambers. You will need to make some note and draw some sketches for this activity.

1. Draw as many Hieroglyphs as possible—Look on the walls of the tomb and find and draw all the different symbols. Can you work out what any of the drawings mean?
2. Create your own Egyptian cartouche using the designs you have discovered .
