## British Historical Eras – Orienteering Race

- Look at the list of the names of eras in British history.
- Decide which one came first. Put a number 1 next to this.
- Run to the control point and look at the control marker number (1st,2nd,3rd or 4th number). If it is a number 1, you were correct.
- Now decide which era came second. Put a number 2 next to this. Then run to the control point and check with the control marker number. If it is a 2, you were correct.
- Carry on until you have numbered all the eras in the correct order.
