

# Les Nombres 1-30



## Objective

- To consolidate the knowledge of numbers 1-30 in French, with a focus on listening skills.



## Equipment

- Outdoor/indoor space
- Handkerchief



## Preparation

- Pupils should have been previously introduced to the numbers 1-30.
- This activity should take place in an open outdoor/indoor space.
- Ensure pupils are familiar with the rules of the game.
- Split the class into 2 equal teams.
- Make 2 lines, facing each other.
- Each facing pair is given a different French number between 1 and 30.



## Instructions

- The teacher stands in the middle of the two rows holding a handkerchief (mouchoir).
- The teacher shouts a number in French. The pair of pupils with that number race to the teacher.
- The pupil who grabs the mouchoir first wins a point for their team.
- When each pair have had a chance to grab the mouchoir, the teacher can give each pair a different number and the game can be repeated.



## Other information

- This activity is suitable for KS1/2/3, depending on their starting point of learning the language.
- If there is an odd number of pupils, one may play the role of the teacher.
- Numbers 1-30 in French:  
un, deux, trois, quatre, cinq, six, sept, huit, neuf, dix, onze, douze, treize, quatorze, quinze, seize, dix-sept, dix-huit, dix-neuf, vingt, vingt et un, vingt-deux, vingt-trois, vingt-quatre, vingt-cinq, vingt-six, vingt-sept, vingt-huit, vingt-neuf, trente
