

Los Animales



Objective

- To learn the Spanish names for 11 animals and their plurals.



Equipment

- Enrich School Orienteering Map
- Orienteering Control Markers
- Activity Sheet
- Answer Sheet



Preparation

- Pupils should have previously been introduced to the vocabulary for the 11 animals.
- Pupils could do this activity in pairs or small groups.
- Give each pair/group an Activity Sheet.



Instructions

- Pupils use their Enrich School Orienteering Map to locate specified control points.
- At each one, they identify the animal from the control marker and circle the correct Spanish name from a choice of three.
- They then write the correct plural (two of the animal).



Other information

- This could be used for KS 1, 2 or 3, depending on the pupils' starting point of reading the language.

Note the plural of fish: pez - peces (z-c)
If the animal ends in an 'a' or 'o', add an 's'.
If the animal ends in a consonant, add 'es'
