

Los Números 1-10



Objective

- To consolidate and become more competent in the use of numbers 1–10 in Spanish.



Equipment

- Enrich Phonics and Numbers Control Markers
- Activity Sheet



Preparation

- Children should have been previously introduced to the numbers 1-10 in Spanish.
- Children could do this activity in pairs.
- This activity should take place where the school's Phonics and Numbers Control Markers are located.
- Give each pair an Activity Sheet and pen/pencil.
- Explain to the children how to complete the Activity Sheet.



Instructions

- Children locate the Phonics/Number Marker from the picture on their activity sheet.
- They write the first number from the marker (i.e. the one on the left hand side of the marker) on their sheet in digit/s.
- They must then write the Spanish word for that number on their Activity Sheet. (They can either write it from memory or copy the correct word from the box on the Activity Sheet.)
- Each child should then say the word out loud to their partner in their best Spanish accent.



Other information

- This activity can be used for KS1 or 2, depending on their starting point of learning Spanish.
- As a follow on/extension activity, children could practice writing/saying the numbers 1-10 in Spanish in the correct order.
