## Los Números 10-100

- For pupils to consolidate/ demonstrate their knowledge of Spanish numbers in tens from 10-100.
- Focus on reading skills.


## Equipment

- Outdoor/indoor space
- Hoops
- Sets of number cards in tens, written in Spanish $10,20,30,40,50,60,70,80,90,100$ (one set per group).


## Preparation

- Pupils should have been previously introduced to the numbers 10-100.
- This activity should take place in an open outdoor/indoor space.
- Split the class into teams (e.g. 5 pupils per group).
- Set up hoops, one per team, at one end of the playing area. Each hoop contains a set of Spanish number cards in tens (10-100), mixed up and placed face down.


## Instructions

- Each team lines up at the end of the playing area, opposite their hoop.
- The teacher gives a signal and the first pupil in each team runs to collect a card from their hoop.
- When they get back to their team, the next child can run to collect a card.
- When the team have collected all their cards, they must arrange them on the floor in the correct order, 10-100.
- The winning team is the one who completes this first.


## Other information

- This activity is suitable for $\mathrm{KS} 1 / 2 / 3$, depending on their starting point of learning the language.
