

Los Números 1-30



Objective

- To consolidate the knowledge of numbers 1-30, with a focus on listening skills.



Equipment

- Outdoor/indoor space
- Handkerchief



Preparation

- Pupils should have been previously introduced to the numbers 1-30.
- This activity should take place in an open outdoor/indoor space.
- Ensure pupils are familiar with the rules of the game.
- Split the class into 2 equal teams.
- Teams make 2 lines, facing each other.
- Each facing pair is given a different Spanish number between 1 and 30.



Instructions

- The teacher stands in the middle of the two rows holding a handkerchief (pañuelo).
- The teacher shouts a number in Spanish. The pair of pupils with that number race to the teacher.
- The pupil who grabs the pañuelo first wins a point for their team.
- When each pair have had a chance to grab the pañuelo, the teacher can give each pair a different number and the game can be repeated.



Other information

- This activity is suitable for KS1,2 or 3, depending on their starting point of learning the language.
- If there is an odd number of pupils, one pupil may play the role of the teacher.
- Numbers 1-30 in Spanish:
Uno, dos, tres, cuatro, cinco, seis, siete, ocho, nueve, diez, once, doce, trece, catorce, quince, dieciséis, diecisiete, dieciocho, diecinueve, veinte, veintiuno, veintidós, veintitrés, veinticuatro, veinticinco, veintiséis, veintisiete, veintiocho, veintinueve, treinta.
