

World Cup Orienteering Quiz



Objective

- A fun and active way for each child to choose a team to follow in the 2022 World Cup.
- A world cup quiz in which children practice their map-reading and orienteering skills.
- Follow-up activities to help children develop their geographical knowledge and research skills.



Preparation

- Prior to the activity, print off a class set of 32 Activity Cards (one for each team in the tournament). Place the cards into a bag or box.
- Each child draws one card out of the bag and box (without looking).
- If there are fewer than 32 children in the class, the 'spare' cards could be for the whole class or for the class teacher.
- If there are more than 32 children in the class, some children will need draw out a team as a pair.
- Provide each of the groups with the map of the school site and highlight the location of the control points to them.
- Print off the numbered list of teams.
- Print off the World Cup Quiz Activity Sheet and the Follow-on Activity Sheets that you will use with your class. (Teachers can select from these according to the age/ability of their children.)



Other information

There are two different **Follow-On Activity Sheets**:

1. A template for children to colour the kit of their football team and flag of its country, with two simple 'country questions' (continent and capital city) for children to complete.
2. More advanced questions about their team's country for children to research and complete.

There is a teacher's answer sheet for the World Cup Orienteering Quiz.

Instructions

- **World Cup Orienteering Sweep**
- Children look at the picture of the animal on their Activity Card. They have to use their map to locate orienteering control points on the school site until they find the control marker which has a picture of their animal on it.
- (Younger children could do this activity in small groups, supervised by an adult, with the group locating control markers together until each child in the group has found the control marker which has a picture of their animal on it.)
- When children have located the control marker which has a picture of their animal on it, they record the numbers from the marker as instructed on their Activity Card, and complete the simple sum.
- They then return to the starting point. The answer to the sum on their Activity Card gives the number of their team from the teacher's 'Numbered List of Teams' sheet. Teachers can also record children's names against their teams on this sheet.
- **World Cup Orienteering Quiz**
- Children could do this activity in pairs
- The Activity Sheet has a set of quiz questions on the World Cup, each of which has three possible answers.
- Each pair chooses one of their questions and ticks against what they decide is the correct answer.
- Using their orienteering map, they then check the answer by running to the control point for that question. *The 4th letter from the control marker is next to the correct answer.*
- They then decide on the answer for the next question and run to the control point to check their answer – and so on.
