

Orienteering Grammar and Punctuation Practice



Objective

To revise key knowledge of grammar and punctuation.



Equipment

- Enrich School Orienteering Map
- Orienteering Control Markers
- Activity Sheets (1,2,3)
- Answer Sheets



Preparation

- Children should have been introduced to the concepts included in this activity prior to completing it.
- There is an answer sheet for each Activity Sheet.
- Children could do this activity in pairs or small groups.
- Provide each pair with an Activity Sheet and an Enrich Orienteering Map.
- Explain to children how to complete the Activity Sheet.



Instructions

- The Activity Sheet has a series of questions about grammar and punctuation, each of which has three possible answers to choose from.
- Each question is linked to a specific control point.
- Children select an answer to the question. They can then check to see if they were correct by locating the control point linked to the question, using their Enrich School Orienteering Map. A specified number (e.g. 4th, 2nd) on the control marker is next to the correct answer.



Other information

- Children could answer individual questions, then check their answer by visiting the control point, before answering the next question.
- Alternatively, they could complete all the questions, then check each of their answers by visiting all of the specified control points.
