2	A feud between two powerful families, the Montagues and the Capulets, ends in bloodshed. But a young man from the Montagues falls in love with a young girl from the Capulets – with tragic consequences.		
8	Three witches tell a Scottish soldier that he will become King of Scotland. Encouraged by his wife, he murders the king and becomes the new king himself. But the murders continue until he is killed in a great battle and a new king of Scotland is crowned.		
14	A ship is wrecked in a storm and its survivors find themselves on a strange island with mysterious inhabitants. The play has a happy ending, with wrongs done in the past being forgiven and a family re-united – but not before the characters have gone through lots of mysterious events.		
6	Some important men in Rome fear that Rome’s leader is becoming too powerful. They plot against him and finally assassinate him. However, the leader’s friends seek revenge and raise an army against the plotters. The two sides meet in a great battle which leaves the main plotters dead and Mark Antony as ruler in Rome.		
13	A wicked English nobleman will do anything to become King of England. He lies, cheats and murders his way to the throne. However, he is finally repaid for his crimes and misdeeds when he is killed in a great battle, and the Earl of Richmond takes the crown and becomes King of England.		
9	Two young men and two young girls run away to the forest, only to have a mischievous fairy make both of the boys fall in love with the same girl. At the same time, the King of the Fairies has quarrelled with his queen and he sends the same fairy to play a trick on her. After lots of tricks and confusion, the play has a happy ending.
