

# Getting to Know You



## Objective

- To provide opportunities for students to get to know each other by taking part in fun, team building activities.
- To help students orientate themselves around the school building and school site.



## Equipment

- Enrich Orienteering Control Markers
- Enrich School Orienteering Map
- Activity Sheets



## Preparation

- Students could do this activity in pairs.
  - Provide each pair with a copy of the school's orienteering map.
  - Provide each student with a copy of the appropriate Activity Sheet.
  - There is a pre-prepared Activity Sheet.
  - Alternatively, teachers can use the editable Activity Sheet and insert their own selection of control points and/or change or substitute questions.
  - Explain how to complete the Activity Sheet to students.
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## Instructions

- Students use their orienteering map to locate each of the control points on their Activity Sheet. They can visit the control points in any order.
- At each control point, the pair records the 3<sup>rd</sup> letter from the control marker.
- Each student then gives their partner their response to the 'Getting to Know You' question for that control point. Partners need to listen carefully so that they can recall as much as possible (and can also make notes on their Activity Sheet).
- They continue until they have responded to all the 'Getting to Know You' questions on their Activity Sheet.



## Other information

- When all students have completed the activity and returned to the start, each pair takes a turn to introduce each other to the group based on their responses to the "Getting to Know You" questions.
