

# Hunt the Marker

## Introduction to Orienteering (Phonics and Number Course)



### Objective

- Locate points in an area of the school site using a simple map.
- Record simple information.



### Equipment

- Enrich Phonics and Number Map.
- Enrich Phonics and Number Markers
- Activity Sheets 1,2,3,4,5
- Phonics and Number Marker Images



### Preparation

- Children could take part in this activity in pairs or small groups.
- Provide each pair with a copy of the school's Enrich Phonics and Number Map and with one of the Activity Sheets.
- Explain or demonstrate to the children how to use their map to locate Phonics and Number Markers and how to complete the Activity Sheet.



### Instructions

- Children use their map to find the location of the Phonics and Number Markers.
- At each marker they look at the picture. If it is one of the six on their Activity Sheet, they record the numbers from the marker (ie the numbers 1-10 on the left hand side of the market and the numbers 11-20 on the right hand side) in the boxes below the picture.
- When they have located and recorded the information from all the markers on their Activity Sheet, they return to the teacher.
- Children can either complete the Activity Sheet by locating and recording all 6 markers, or can locate and record 3 markers, check these with the teacher, and then locate and record the next 3 markers on their Activity Sheet.



### Other information

- If the Activity Sheets are laminated, they can be used on multiple occasions if children use whiteboard pens to record numbers.
- Teachers can check the children's Activity Sheet using a copy of the Phonics and Number Marker images.
