# Transition Favourites (Using Enrich Orienteering Control Markers) 

## Objective

- To help students orientate themselves around the school building and locate specific rooms. To provide opportunities for students to get to know each other by taking part in fun, team building activities.


## Equipment

- Enrich Orienteering Control Markers
- Enrich School Orienteering Map
- Activity Sheet


## Preparation

Students could do this activity in pairs/small groups.
Provide each pair/group with a copy of the school's orienteering map.

## Either:

- Print off a copy of the Activity Sheet for each student.
Or:
- Identify up to 6 orienteering control points on the school site that students will have to locate to carry out this activity.
- Fill in the numbers of the control points on the editable Activity Sheet and identify a number (1st/2nd/3rd or 4th) from the control marker.
- (NB the images for all of the control markers are available from the 'Resources and Training' section on the 'My Account' page of the Enrich hub.)
- Fill in a 'favourite' for each activity.
- Print off a copy of the edited Activity Sheet for each student.

Explain to students how to complete the Activity Sheet.
