British Towns and Cities



Objective

Identify major towns and cities of the four UK nations.



Equipment

- Enrich School Orienteering Map
- Orienteering Control Markers
- Activity Sheets
- UK Atlas (optional)



Preparation

- Children should have been introduced to major towns and cities of the UK nations prior to doing this activity.
- Children could do the activity in small groups or pairs.
- Provide each pair/group with an Activity Sheet and an Enrich School Orienteering Map.
- Children could use a UK atlas whilst completing this activity (optional)



Instructions

- Children use their Enrich School Orienteering Map to locate the control points identified on their Activity Sheet.
- Each control point is linked to one of the four UK nations. When children visit the control point, they
 must select the towns/cities that are in that nation from the table in their Activity Sheet. They identify
 them by writing the specified number from the control marker for that control point (1st/2nd/3rd/4th)
 next to each of the towns/cities.
- They continue until they have visited all the control points and linked all the towns/cities in the table with a UK nation.



Other information

- As a follow-on activity, children could use their atlases to look for other other major towns/cities for each UK nation.
- Activity Sheets could be laminated so that they can be used multiple times.
