Commonwealth Countries



Objective

A fun orienteering activity where children identify some of the Commonwealth countries using letters from the control markers.



Equipment

- Enrich School Orienteering Map
- Orienteering Markers
- Activity Sheet
- Clipboards (optional)





Preparation

- Children could do this activity in pairs or small groups.
- Provide each pair/group with an orienteering map and Activity Sheet.
- Children could visit the 15 orienteering markers in any order.



Instructions

- On the Activity Sheet, each of the 15 Enrich Education Orienteering Control Markers is linked to a Commonwealth country. The name of the country has several missing letters.
- Children locate the control points using their Enrich School Orienteering Map.
- When they locate a control point, the missing letters in the country's name are included in the letters on the control marker.
- The number above each missing letter shows which letter from the marker should be used (ie 1^{st} , 2^{nd} , 3^{rd} or 4^{th} letter).
- Children use the letters from the marker to complete the country's name on their Activity Sheet.
- They do this at each control point until they have completed the names of all 15 countries.



Other information

- As a follow-on activity, children could use an atlas to locate each of the 15 countries and find out more information about them.
