

Maths Vocabulary Orienteering



Objective

To reinforce children's knowledge of key maths vocabulary.



Equipment

- Orienteering Control Markers
- Enrich School Orienteering Map
- Activity Sheet



Preparation

- This Activity provides opportunities for children to re-visit and apply some key maths vocabulary: multiply; minus; sum of; product of; divide; subtract; take away; difference; share; total.
- Children could do the activity in pairs or small groups.
- Provide each pair/group with an Activity Sheet and an Enrich School Orienteering Map.
- Explain to the children how to do the activity.



Instructions

- Children use their Enrich School Orienteering Map to locate orienteering control points.
- At each control point they have to record specific letters from the control marker on their Activity Sheet (1st/2nd/3rd/4th letters).
- They then use key maths vocabulary to make a calculation using these numbers and record the answer on their Activity Sheet.
- They continue until they have visited each of the 10 control points identified for this activity.
