

Water Cycle Orienteering Challenge

- Below are all the different stages in the water cycle.
- You have to look at all the other stages and put them in order.
- Put a 1 next to the 1st stage in the cycle.
- Now run to the control point and look at the control marker number (1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th number). If it is a number 1, you were correct.
- Now decide which stage is the 2nd stage in the cycle. Put a number 2 next to this.
- Now run to the control point and check with the control marker number. If it is a 2, you were correct.
- Carry on until you have numbered all the stages in the correct order.
