

Roman Numerals 3



Objective

To reinforce children's knowledge of Roman numerals.



Equipment

- Orienteering Control Markers
- Enrich School Orienteering Map
- Activity Sheets
- Answer Sheet



Preparation

- This activity requires children to convert three-digit numbers to Roman numerals.
- Children could do the activity in pairs or small groups.
- Provide each pair/group with Activity Sheets and an Enrich School Orienteering Map.
- Explain to the children how to do the activity.



Instructions

- Children use their Enrich School Orienteering Map to locate orienteering control points.
- At each control point they have to record three specific numbers from the control marker on their Activity Sheet.
- They convert the three-digit number they have created into Roman numerals and record the answer on their Activity Sheet.



Other information

- Children could explore how Roman numerals are used in everyday contexts e.g. on clock faces, book chapters, the names of kings and queens etc.
