## Reading Numbers 1 - 10 as Words

## Objective

For children to practise reading numbers 1-10 as words

## Equipment

- Phonics and Number Markers.
- Activity Sheet
- Phonics and Number Marker Image Sheet


## Preparation

- Children could carry out this activity individually or in pairs.
- The activity should take place in the area of the school site where the school's phonics and number markers are located.
- Children begin the activity at a central point within this area.
- Provide each pair with an activity sheet.
- Explain the activity to the children.
- Print off a copy of the Phonics and Number Marker Images.


## Instructions

- Children circle one of the numbers (written as a word) at the top of their activity sheet.
- These numbers are not in order, so children have to read each one they circle.
- They then have to find the marker which shows that number on the left-hand side of the image (as a numeral).
- They write this umber (as a numeral) in the box next to the image from that marker on their activity sheet.
- NB Children must circle a number before they find the marker with the same numeral on it. They should do this one number at a time. This will ensure that they have to read the word for each number.
- Teachers can use the Phonics and Number Marker Images Sheet to quickly check children's activity sheets.
